1. Principals (Pay Scale: Rs. 37400-67000+10000 AGP):

Qualifications:

- i. A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) by a recognized University.
- ii. A Ph.D. Degree in concerned/allied/relevant discipline(s) in the institution concerned with evidence of published work and research guidance.
- iii. Associate Professor/Professor with a total experience of fifteen years of teaching/ research/ administration in Universities, Colleges and other institutions of higher education.
- (iv) A minimum score of 400 points in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as set out in UGC Regulation

Note:

- (a) **Candidates are also required to submit their five sets of Bio-data and five sets of reprints of five major publications along with the application for evaluation purpose. such publications submitted by the candidate shall have been published subsequent to the period from which the teacher was placed in the Assistant Professor stage-II.**
- (b) A relaxation of 5% is admissible at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- (c) A relaxation of 5% is admissible, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- (d) Good academic record means atleast 2nd class with 50% marks in graduation level

Qualifications:

- (1) PhD in Physical Education.
- (2) Experience of at least ten years as University Deputy or fifteen years as University Assistant DPEs/College (Selection Grade)
- (3) Participation in at least two national/international seminars/conferences.
- (4) Consistently good appraisal reports.
- (5) Evidence of organizing competitions and conducting coaching camps of at least two weeks duration.
- (6) Evidence of having produced good performance teams/athletes for competitions like state/national/interuniversity/ Combined university etc.
- (7) A minimum score of 400 points in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as set out in UGC Regulation.

Qualifications:

- (1) A Master's Degree in Library Science /Information science/ Documentation with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade of B in the UGC seven points scale and consistently good academic record set out in these Regulations.
- (2) At least thirteen years Deputy Librarian in a University library or eighteen years experience as College Librarian.
- (3) Evidence of Innovative library service and organization of published work.
- (4) Desirable: A M.Phil/PhD. Degree in library science/ Information science/ documentation/archives and manuscript-keeping.
- (5) A minimum score of 400 points in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as set out in UGC Regulation.

4. **Deputy Librarian -2**

Qualifications:

- (1) A Master Degree in library science/information science/ documentation with at least 55% of the marks or its equivalent grade of B in the UGC Seven points scale and a consistently good academic record.
- (2) five Years experience as an Assistant University Librarian/College Librarian.
- (3) Evidence of Innovative library service and organization of published work and professional commitment, computerization of library.
- (4) Desirable: A M.Phil/PhD. Degree in library science / information science Documentation/Archives and manuscript-keeping/computerization of library.
- (5) A minimum score of 300 points in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as set out in UGC Regulation.

Note:Candidates are also required to submit their five sets of Bio-data and five sets of reprints of three major publications along with the application form for evaluation purpose.

5. **Land Landscape Officer -1**

Qualifications:

- (1) M.Sc. Land Scaping & Floriculture with 55% marks
or
M.Sc. Horticulture (with specialization in Land Scaping/Floriculture) with 55% marks
or
M.Sc. Agriculture with 55% marks.
- (2) Two years experience in Land Scaping/Floriculture.
- (3) Punjabi upto Matric level is compulsory.

BA with Post Graduate Diploma in Physical Education. Diploma in Coaching from NIS in the respective game and participation in Inter-University/Senior National/ Federation Cup tournament.

OR

MA in Physical Education/M.P.Ed with Diploma in Coaching from NIS in the respective game and participation in Inter-University/Senior National/ Federation Cup tournament.

OR

A Very outstanding sportsperson with Bachelor's degree in any discipline and having participated in Olympic Games or upto third position holder in World Cup/Commonwealth Games/Asian Games or Arjuna Award or Daronacharya award or Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award or having Coached and accompanied the Indian team as its coach in his/her game/ sport for international competition or having produced international players.

Shooting :

At least Bachelor 's degree in any stream and should be a position holder at the national/international level competition. He/she should have experience of coaching at the University/State/National/International level.

OR

A Very outstanding sportsperson with Bachelor's degree in any discipline and having participated in Olympic Games or upto third position holder in World Cup/Commonwealth Games/Asian Games or Arjuna Award or Daronacharya award or Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award or having Coached and accompanied the Indian team as its coach in his/her game/ sport for international competition or having produced international players.

7. **Jr.Tech.(Computer), Univ. College, Jalandhar-1**(on contractual basis initially for three years)
(Pay : Rs.8000/-pm fixed)

Qualifications:

1. BCA/B.Sc.(IT)/B.Sc Computer Science/B.Sc. Economics or equivalent thereto or BA/B.Sc. with Computer Science as an elective Subject, with atleast 50% marks.

OR

Post Graduate/Graduate with 50% marks and PGDCA from GNDU or equivalent thereof.

2. Punjabi upto Matric standard is essential.

2. **Persons already in service must send their applications through their employer. All those candidates working in organizations/institutions including affiliated colleges of the university may be allowed to appear in interview without No Objection Certificate with the condition that in case the candidate is selected, no extension in joining time will be allowed. Such candidates are required to give an undertaking on the format available on university website: www.gndu.ac.in. All such candidates will be given standard joining time i.e. one month from the issuance of appointment letter.**
3. The candidates are required to apply separately for each post earmarked for each Deptt. / Station.
4. **Incomplete applications in any respect or without the prescribed fee or received after the due date will not be entertained.**
5. University reserves the right to fill or not to fill up the posts and to call only suitable candidates for interview.
6. The number of posts can be increased or decreased before the interview.
7. Candidates within India may not be considered in absentia. Higher start in the grade may be given depending upon qualifications and experience of the candidates.
8. C.V. of any candidate can be placed before the Selection Committee at the time of Interview.
9. **IMPORTANT: Applicants for the posts of Principals/Director Physical Education & Sports/Librarian/Deputy Librarian must attach the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) Proforma as indicative Appendix III Table II(C)/V(C)/VIII(C) (duly filled-in all respects by them) and attested copies of supporting documents, with their applications.**
10. A minimum score of 300 points for the post of Deputy Librarian/ equivalent cadres and 400 points for Principals/Director Physical Education & Sports/Librarian/equivalent cadres from category III of APIs are required.
