Title: Times New Roman font size 14, title case, bold and centre aligned

Author(s) Names: Times New Roman font size 12, title case, bold and presenting author's name marked with asterisk(*) and centre aligned

Affiliations: Times New Roman font size 12, title case (along with E-mail address of the corresponding author) and centre aligned

Text: Times New Roman font size 12 and justified

Interested researchers can submit full length articles which will be peer reviewed. Selected good quality research papers will be published in a special volume of a reputed and indexed National journal.

Guidelines for Full length paper

Submit soft copy by E Mail and only ONE hard copy

Manuscript should be typed in double space on A4 size paper and organized as: **Title** (In Capital, followed by Name(s) of Author(s) and Address(es), phone, e-mail etc. in running letters) Abstract, *Key words*, Introduction, Materials and methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgement/s and References. (Main heading should be in Capital bold and sub heading should be in running bold letters). Tables and Graphs should be typed on separate pages; Photographs should be good, sufficiently enlarged on glossy paper. Scanned images of graphs and tables will not be considered.
