Preface

Dominance of science in Punjab became evident only after independence, where, due to it, profound changes occurred in the methods & techniques of cultivation. This led to the increase of food grains but the variety of crops dwindled considerably. The series of revolutions passing under the titles of green, white and blue, coupled with unorganized development has dwindled biodiversity, disrupted environment, mismanaged resources and created filthy dwellings in most parts of the state. The new situation with respect to agriculture has become critical from ecological point of view as well. It has reduced drastically crop biodiversity and biodiversity in general, over utilized the meager water resources resulting in lowering of water table, poisoned the surrounding through overuse of insecticides, starved the soil of natural nutrients and reduced the green cover around the villages. In spite of apparent signs of development, there is in-appropriate disposal of household garbage.

Thus, there are many location specific problems in Punjab which require the help of science and R&D. It is, therefore, proposed that brainstorming workshops be organized in the state **to motivate the researchers to commence R&D on state specific issues.** It is felt that the brainstorming workshops will help the researchers of the state to identify problems of the state and highlight areas requiring immediate attention through technology and resource management. They can further prepare proposals to elaborate/ find solutions for each sector needing scientific intervention which can be elaborated further at various other levels. The objectives of the workshop are to:

- 1) Mobilize the Universities and R&D Institutes to discuss the problems of the state requiring S&T intervention.
- 2) Motivate the researchers to commence R&D on state specific issues.
- 3) To open avenues for further scientific and systematic research on strategic problems needing immediate solutions.

The brainstorming workshop will involve technical sessions on:

- Information on R&D being conducted by the Universities and R&D institutions for location specific problems in the sectors of agriculture, environment & ecology, health, water irrigation, industry etc.
- Discussions to take up/ initiate systematic research on strategic problems needing immediate solutions in the state.

Department of Botanical and Environmental Sciences and PSCST jointly intend to organize one day brain storming workshop in GND University, with your active collaboration to meet the above stated objectives. This would also enable the researchers and scientists to frame research proposals which could then be submitted for sanction to State Science & Technology Programme (SSTP) www.dst-sstp.org, DST, GOI through PSCST.

Who can apply:

Researchers and teachers working in different science & technology **departments of GNDU Campuses and its constituted and affiliated colleges** can participate to discuss problems of state requiring Science and Technology intervention. They will be motivated to plan and submit solution oriented research problems on state specific issues.

Principals & Institutional Heads are requested to nominate faculty from Science & Technology departments
