MEMBERSHIP AND PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERS

The membership is open to any person associated, directly or indirectly to promote and encourage the growth and development of science of Thermodynamics and those scientific disciplines ancillary there.

Membership Fee:

- 1. Ordinary Member
- : Ordinary Membership fee is Rs. 500/-. A member failing to pay the annual subscription by the end of March of the following year shall cease to be a Member.
- 2. Life Member
- Life Membership fee is Rs. 3000/-. An Ordinary member can compound maximum three consecutive year subscription to become Life Member. For example an Ordinary Member may become a life member in the subsequent year by paying Rs. 2500/-, Rs. 2000/- or Rs. 1500/- after one, two or three year's of ordinary membership, respectively. A life Member shall have all the privileges of a member during his/her life time.
- 3. Industry or Corporate Membership

Industry/ corporate can have only Ordinary Membership. The fee for Industry/Corporate will be ten times (for one representative) the ordinary membership fee for academicians. They can participate in discussion and will not be entitled to contest election of any kind in the society.
